Richard Donno
Founder – Donno Landscaping Inc.

Richard Donno is a highly respected and successful landscape contractor. He founded Donno Landscaping Inc. in 1962, specializing in construction and horticulture services.

Richard's career in landscaping began at the early age of fifteen. Working on a private estate in Dix Hills, he propagated flowers and plants in a greenhouse, and then planted and maintained them, all under the direction of the proprietor who was a master horticulturist.

Richard attended Half Hollow Hills High School and then attended Suffolk Community College where he earned an Associates degree in Business Administration. In 1964 he continued his education majoring in finance at Adelphi University, graduating in 1968 with a degree Bachelor of Business Administration. While completing his college requisites at night, he continued working on the estate and eventually started his own landscape business, Donno Landscaping Inc. In addition he went to work for Shell Oil Company in New York City. In two years, he quickly rose to the position of Accounts Supervisor, managing finances for all Shell Chemical's many divisions. In 1970, upon Shell's move to Texas, Richard decided to remain on Long Island putting down roots and pursue his love for horticulture.

Richard has two beautiful children, Lance and Nicole, and grandchildren, Olivia and Isabella. His father, Aldo Donno, was prominent in political circles and inspired him to get involved in politics. He started as a local committeeman and in 1973 ran on the Republican ticket for County Legislator in the 15th Legislative District in Suffolk County. Unfortunately, after a highly contested run, Richard lost by 350 votes.

This led to a continued burning desire to be of service to his community. He has achieved board membership in several prominent organizations including LINLA, The Long Island Nursery and Landscape Association. He was instrumental in making the annual golf outing a very successful tournament. Foremost is a lifetime of dedication to ACLD, Adults and Children with Learning and Developmental Disabilities. This is his charity of choice. ACLD is very close to his heart as his son Lance is developmentally challenged and attends their programs daily. He has served on the finance committee and has been involved with numerous programs in an effort to enrich Lance's life and those of his peers. Richard provided a home for Lance and six members of his now extended family to live in. Richard and Lance were honored by ACLD in 2001 at their annual golf fund raiser.

So now after presiding on the Board of Long Island Charities for a number of years he is being honored on this very special Golden Anniversary celebrating their 50th "Man of the Year". Funny how life repeats itself!

It is Richard's belief that for those of us more fortunate to be of sound mind and body, we should stand tall above all mankind to help those who are in need. These men and women we are helping today should never walk alone in their quest for an enviable life. They never have to look far and one of us will be there every step of the way to guide them, provide for them, and love them.
